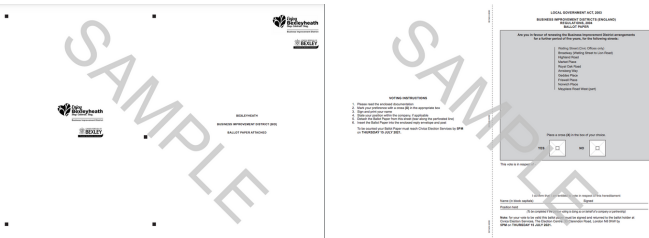
### **FREE COURSES THIS JULY**
